Eden Mennonite Church, Moundridge KS / First Congregational Church, Western Springs IL / Christ Episcopal Church, Denver CO / Redeemer Lutheran Church, St. Paul MN / Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary, Milwaukee WI / Hope Presbyterian Church, Springfield IL / St. Monica R.C., St. Louis MO / St. John's Lutheran Church, Decatur IL / Pilgrim Lutheran Church, Milwaukee WI / Immanuel Lutheran Church, Medford WI / St. Brigid R.C., San Diego, CA / Principia College, Elsau IL.

Presently we are in the final stages of completing the 21 stop organ for Eden Mennonite Church in Moundridge, Kansas. The moving of the organ is scheduled for the 1st of June and the technical installation will be completed before our shop vacation. Tonal finishing will commence after vacation. Thanks to my fine crew and good planning, this organ will be finished three months before the promised date.

The completion of the positive organ for the First Congregational Church in Western Springs is scheduled for August. Albert and Dan, our cabinet makers, will start soon on the case for Redeemer Lutheran Church, St. Paul.

I have been busy in preparing drawings and pipe scaling for the metal pipes in preparation for my visit to the pipe supplier in Germany next month. I will also oversee the loading of the next pipe shipment (Western Springs, St. Paul and Denver). The pipes for Mequon, Madison, Springfield and St. Louis will be sent in October.
