Several weeks ago you have received an announcement concerning two important events which will be taking place on the campus of Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary during the month of April. We are again issuing these announcements.

CHAPEL ORGAN DEDICATION - The 23 rank Martin Ott organ which has been built in the small chapel of Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary will be dedicated in special services on April 14, 1991 at 3:00 and 7:00 P.M. Pastor Bryan Gerlach of Sacramento, CA will be the guest organist. Prof. James Tiefel will be the preacher and Prof. emeritus Martin Albrecht will read the dedication rite.

The second special event will take place one week later.

FESTIVAL CONCERT - Three Wisconsin Synod choirs will join together on Sunday, April 21, 1991, to present a sacred concert entitled "Let Every Instrument Be Tuned for Praise." The choirs are **The Lutheran Chorale** of Milwaukee, **The Treble Choir** of Dr. Martin Luther College and **The Seminary Chorus** of Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary. Each choir will present individual anthems and will also join to form a 200 voice festival chorus. Organ, orchestra and soloists will accompany the chorus, as will congregational participation. The concert will be held in the Auditorium of Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary in Mequon at 2:30 P.M. There is no admission charge; a free-will offering will be gathered.

Two senior students of Dr. Martin Luther College will present a joint organ recital on the new Martin Ott Organ in the Seminary's small chapel at 1:00 P.M.
